

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $441,987 = 400,000 + 40,000 + 1,000 + 900 + 80 + 7$

Find the missing numbers:

- 1) $600,000 + 20,000 + 2,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 90 = 622,190$
- 2) $200,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 900 + 30 = 270,930$
- 3) $700,000 + 40,000 + 7,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 747,100$
- 4) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 8,000 + 200 + 70 + 3 = 808,273$
- 5) $300,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 3,000 + 600 + 5 = 373,605$
- 6) $900,000 + 30,000 + 8,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 3 = 938,053$
- 7) $400,000 + 40,000 + 2,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 442,002$
- 8) $800,000 + 2,000 + 100 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 3 = 802,123$
- 9) $300,000 + 70,000 + 600 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 370,608$
- 10) $900,000 + 50,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80 + 7 = 952,087$

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
