

## Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

### Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example:  $328,141 = 300,000 + 20,000 + 8,000 + 100 + 40 + 1$

Find the missing numbers:

- 1)  $400,000 + 10,000 + 6,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 2 = 416,092$
- 2)  $900,000 + 20,000 + 1,000 + 50 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 921,053$
- 3)  $100,000 + 2,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 50 + 8 = 102,958$
- 4)  $800,000 + 9,000 + 800 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 809,809$
- 5)  $100,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 300 + 10 = 108,310$
- 6)  $600,000 + 50,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 40 + 1 = 650,141$
- 7)  $200,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 2,000 + 300 + 9 = 262,309$
- 8)  $100,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 6,000 + 400 + 2 = 136,402$
- 9)  $100,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 600 + 90 + 9 = 105,699$
- 10)  $800,000 + 50,000 + 100 + 90 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 850,192$

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
