

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $231,955 = 200,000 + 30,000 + 1,000 + 900 + 50 + 5$

Find the missing numbers:

$$1) \quad 400000 + 30000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 100 + 40 = 432,140$$

$$2) \quad \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1000 + 300 + 9 = 901,309$$

$$3) \quad 900000 + 40000 + 600 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 9 = 940,669$$

$$4) \quad \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 50000 + 500 + 40 + 2 = 850,542$$

$$5) \quad 200000 + 40000 + 9000 + 600 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 249,650$$

$$6) \quad \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 300 + 60 + 7 = 700,367$$

$$7) \quad 500000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 200 + 80 = 503,280$$

$$8) \quad 900000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 400 + 40 + 1 = 910,441$$

$$9) \quad \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 8000 + 10 + 6 = 108,016$$

$$10) \quad 100000 + 10000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80 + 4 = 110,484$$

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6) $\underline{700,000} + 300 + 60 + 7 = 700,367$

7) $500,000 + \underline{3,000} + 200 + 80 = 503,280$

8) $900,000 + \underline{10,000} + 400 + 40 + 1 = 910,441$

9) $\underline{100,000} + 8000 + 10 + 6 = 108,016$

10) $100,000 + 10,000 + \underline{400} + 80 + 4 = 110,484$
