

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $939,786 = 900,000 + 30,000 + 9,000 + 700 + 80 + 6$

Find the missing numbers:

- 1) $900,000 + 30,000 + 7,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 6 = 937,606$
- 2) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80,000 + 4,000 + 300 + 2 = 684,302$
- 3) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 20,000 + 9,000 + 700 + 5 = 729,705$
- 4) $700,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 300 + 70 = 760,370$
- 5) $900,000 + 70,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 70 + 3 = 975,073$
- 6) $800,000 + 70,000 + 8,000 + 700 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 878,704$
- 7) $500,000 + 20,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 8 = 522,008$
- 8) $900,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 40 + 5 = 960,045$
- 9) $900,000 + 50,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 60 + 5 = 958,065$
- 10) $400,000 + 80,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 4 = 480,904$

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
