

Find the missing place value from a 6-digit number

Grade 5 Addition Worksheet

Example: $262,377 = 200,000 + 60,000 + 2,000 + 300 + 70 + 7$

Find the missing numbers:

- 1) $900,000 + 90,000 + 9,000 + 80 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 999,088$
- 2) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 700 + 50 + 5 = 300,755$
- 3) $900,000 + 90,000 + 700 + 60 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 990,769$
- 4) $300,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 4,000 + 30 = 354,030$
- 5) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 80,000 + 1,000 + 40 + 9 = 481,049$
- 6) $100,000 + 200 + 10 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 100,213$
- 7) $600,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 1,000 + 500 + 20 = 621,520$
- 8) $700,000 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 600 + 9 = 702,609$
- 9) $600,000 + 90,000 + 1,000 + 600 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 691,660$
- 10) $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + 40,000 + 800 + 8 = 340,808$

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- 5) $\underline{400,000} + 80,000 + 1,000 + 40 + 9 = 481,049$
- 6) $100,000 + 200 + 10 + \underline{\quad 3 \quad} = 100,213$
- 7) $600,000 + \underline{20,000} + 1,000 + 500 + 20 = 621,520$
- 8) $700,000 + \underline{2,000} + 600 + 9 = 702,609$
- 9) $600,000 + 90,000 + 1,000 + 600 + \underline{\quad 60 \quad} = 691,660$
- 10) $\underline{300,000} + 40,000 + 800 + 8 = 340,808$
